Matchu from SE Uplift joined the meeting to present services offered by his organization. Sarah expressed interest in serving as the SE Uplift liaison; however, she would need someone else to take minutes until the Secretary position is filled. Louise agreed.

The board officially recognized Natalie's removal from the board due to 3 consecutive absences.

New business:

The board discussed the request received from Honk PDX; Louise will reach out to the sender. The board also discussed the first monthly meet up. Comments were positive, such as the venue being better than the church. Others weren't fond of the lack of organization that the general meetings had. For the next meet up, the following options were discussed: AACO Flex Space, Flying Pie.

Louise requested 10 minutes at the next meeting to present a video on zenith oil. The board concluded with a "tentative yes" as we might want to balance the information. Recommended inviting a fire fighter to address concerns.
